Typical for this industry, all delivery processes are synchronized according to Just-in-Time and Just-in-Sequence requirements; even the production critical so-called KO parts are delivered synchronous to the production lines of the manufacturers with the production and in the required sequence. All processes from cross-docking of received goods for the whole plant to the warehouse organization, the pre-assembly through to the synchronized routing control must be planned and controlled according to this principle. The transparency of the processes is hereby secured through special control monitors which are setup for the specific requirements of JIT and JIS processes. In order to improve the inventory and process security even further, RF supported goods receiving, order picking and shipping processes were implemented. Efficiency and quality improvements were achieved also through a comprehensive automation.
